Students of all countries and levels are welcomed to participate or the bass players finished to study last year 2017-2018.

Two prizes categories:

- Galicia Graves Performance Prize (all students, all ages and habilities)
- Galicia Graves Young Talent Award (all students 14 or under)

The prize can remain vacant.

- Selection Round:

Send a video recorded by any medium (computer, phone....) with good sound quality (ONE video for competitor and in ONE TRACK, not edited) playing a FREE CHOICE PIECE or one/two movements from a bigger work. The entire length of the video should be between 3 and 8 minutes. Videos that do not have enough quality will be decalcified.

Piano accompaniment will not be provided.

Send it to **galiciagraves@gmail.com** and include your name, age and category you participate (Young Talent Award or Performance Prize)

Documentation required: ID copy, student accreditation from your current school and an authorization (in case you are under 18, a tutor authorization needed) to publish your video on Galicia Graves's Youtube Channel.

The applicant is responsible for the rights of the contents of the video as well as the people that appear in it. The applicant expressly authorizes Galicia Graves to use its image, through the recordings during the development of the Competition activities, as well as its use and publication for promotional purposes as well as being as transparent as possible in the selection process, on the page web, social networks and in general

- Final Round:

Successful candidates have to play an Imposed work by Featured Composer *John Alexander* in both categories.

For Galicia Graves Young Talent Award aspirants (14 or Under) the work will be send by email.

For Galicia Graves Performance Prize aspirants (Over 14) the imposed work will be send by email and a second piece to choose from:

- *"Capriccio Nº 2"* (David Anderson).
- *"The transience of life"* (Simón García).
- *"Motivy"* (Emil Tabakov).
- 2 contrasting movements of *"Suite im Alten Stil"* (Hans Fryba).

Photocopying scores will NOT be accepted on stage.

Final Round of 2019 Galicia Graves Competition will be in Culleredo (Spain) at the Gustav Mahler Concert Hall of Culleredo's Conservatory of Music on 29th March 2019.

Will be a maximum of 4 finalists for each categories.

Galicia Graves do not pay expenses for the candidate.
